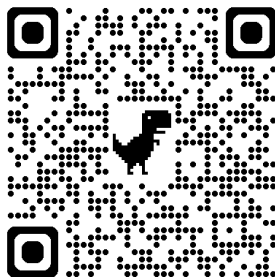
We are particularly interested in hearing from employers in the following STEM-related sectors:
